Whaikaha is working on **Disability System Transformation**.



Disability System Transformation is making big changes to disability support.



Part of the Disability System

Transformation work is making sure more people can use **Enabling Good Lives**.

Enabling Good Lives





Enabling Good Lives is a different way of thinking about disability support.

Enabling Good Lives is about having:

- choice and control in your life
- the support you need and want
- a good life.



As part of the Disability System
Transformation work Whaikaha is
setting up a Transformation
Management **Board**.



A **board** is a group of people who:

- look after how the main things are going
- do not do the everyday work.





The Transformation Management Board will be one of the ways that Whaikaha works together with:

- tāngata whaikaha Māori / disabled Māori
- disabled people.











The Transformation Management Board members will:

- check how the transformation is going
- agree to money going to different things
- look for where the order of things being done can be changed to make transformation go better
- agree what things should be managed:
 - o for the whole country
 - in different parts of the country.

Becoming a member of the Board







The Transformation Management
Board will have 9 members including:

- 3 tāngata whaikaha Māori / disabled Māori
- 3 disabled people
- 3 senior leaders from Whaikaha with 1 of these being the Chief Executive.
